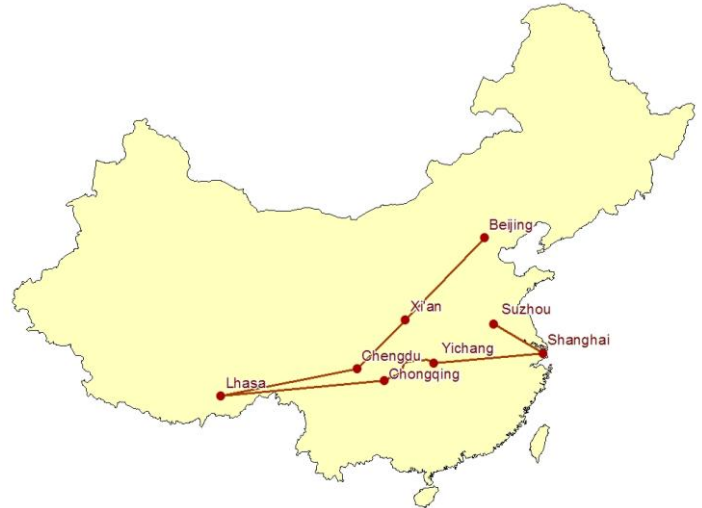

Day 1 & 2: USA/Beijing, China

Depart for Beijing and arrive on the next day. Stay in your deluxe hotel located in the heart of the city.



Day 3: Beijing

Start with **Tiananmen Square** and followed by the **Forbidden City** (UNESCO Heritage Site), in which 24 emperors lived from 1421 to 1911AD. Then **Hutong Tour** by rickshaw, which will bring you to the old residential quarters, where you will visit **houses** of traditional architecture. **Welcome dinner – Roast Peking Duck.** B, L, SD

Day 4: Beijing

Visit the **Temple of Heaven** (UNESCO Heritage Site), a landmark of China built in 1420 AD Here the emperors of Ming and Qing Dynasties worshipped heaven and prayed for abundant harvest. Here you will also see many local people doing various morning exercises. Then we'll drive to the **Great Wall** (UNESCO Heritage Site) at Badaling, the greatest project in ancient China. At lunch place, you'll have a chance to see how the beautiful **cloisonné** are made. B, L

Day 5: Beijing/Xi'an

Today's highlight is the famous **Summer Palace** (UNESCO Heritage Site) – China's largest and best preserved imperial garden (a short boat ride may be available if weather permits). Fly to Xian late afternoon. Stay at your deluxe hotel. B, L

Day 6: Xi'an

Today's tour starts with the ancient **City Wall** built in Ming Dynasty

(1368 – 1644 AD). Then we'll visit the **Museum of History**, one of the finest museums in China. Then the **Small Wild Goose Pagoda** built in Tang Dynasty (618 – 907 AD). Enjoy the **Tang Dynasty Dancing Show with Local Dumpling Dinner**. B, L, SD

Day 7: Xi'an

Today's highlights are the **Terra-cotta Warriors and Horses** (UNESCO Heritage Site) including **Bronze Chariot** and **Circle Vision Movie**. **Noodle-making demonstrations** at lunch. B, L

Day 8: Xi'an/Chengdu

air

Morning flight to Chengdu, home of giant pandas. Today's highlight is the **Panda Breeding Research Center** (UNESCO Heritage Site), where you will visit pandas of various ages, **Museum of Giant Pandas**, and see a **documentary film** show of The Life of Giant Pandas. Then we'll proceed to the **Old Street**, where you will see the **traditional tea service**. Stay in your deluxe hotel in the heart of the city. B, L

Day 9: Chengdu/Lhasa

air

Morning flight to Lhasa, capital of Tibet. En route to the hotel, enjoy the unique view of **mountains and rivers**, visit a **Tibetan village and a school**. Stay in your superior first class hotel with great location (close to Jokhang Temple and Barkhor Street). Have a good rest in the remainder of the day and get used to the high altitude. B, D

Day 10: Lhasa

Today's highlight is the **Potala Palace** (UNESCO Heritage Site), the former Winter Palace of Dalai Lama, which is famed as a "bright pearl" on the "Roof of the World". The next is the **Sera Monastery**, where you will meet many Tibetan monks under training. B, L, D

Day 11: Lhasa

Visit the **Jokhang Temple**, one of Buddhism's holiest shrines. Here you will see Tibetan prayers from various areas. It is a memorable experience to take a stroll in the famous **Barkhor Street** (around the Jokhang Temple) where there are crowds of Tibetan pilgrims. B, L

Day 12: Lhasa/Chongqing

air

Fly to Chongqing and stay in your centrally located deluxe hotel. After refreshing, dine out for famous Sichuan cuisine. B, D

Day 13: Chongqing/Yangtze River Cruise

City tour including the **City Square, Art Gallery, Farmers' Market** and **Stilwell Museum**. Board your deluxe cruise ship after dinner. B, D

Day 14: Yangtze River Cruise

Shore excursion to **Fengdu** (known as Ghost City), a famous historic and cultural site. **Captain's welcome banquet** followed by **Chinese cultural show**. B, L, SD

Day 15: Yangtze River Cruise

Sail through **Qutang Gorge** and **Wu Gorge**. Today's excursion is the sampan boat ride on the beautiful **Shennong Stream**, one of



the tributaries of the Yangtze River. **Captain's farewell dinner** followed by **cabaret show**. B, L, SD

Day 16: Yichang/Shanghai

air

Sail through **Xiling Gorge**. Visit the **Three Gorges Dam**. Arrive in Yichang at noon, fly to Shanghai. Stay in conveniently located deluxe hotel. B, L

Day 17: Shanghai/Suzhou/Shanghai

Enjoy a day-tour to Suzhou, which is well-known as "Venice in the East", "City of Gardens" and "Capital of Silk". The tour in Suzhou includes the **Garden of Master Fishnet** (World Heritage Site), **Silk Spinning Factory** and **boat trip on ancient man-made Grand Canal**. Return to Shanghai in late afternoon. B, L

Day 18: Shanghai

Start the tour with the **Bund**, from where you can enjoy the view of both traditional and modern Shanghai. Then the **Old Town of Shanghai**. The next is the renowned **Shanghai Museum** with priceless collections of jade, bronzes, ceramics, calligraphy and Chinese furniture. Fantastic **Acrobatic Show** after dinner. B, L, D

Day 19: Shanghai /Home

Depart Shanghai and arrive home the same day. B
